# FROM THE DESK OF THE FOUNDER PRESIDENT



The Rotaract Club of S.B.S.C. was installed on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2012 and being under the huge umbrella of Rotary International, the club is engaged in pursuing the three Rotary goals which are societal development, leadership development and professional development. Our club though being one of the newest members of the Rotary family, has been very active throughout the year and **has got unmatched recognition** from Rotary International and the society together.

The whole year was very remarkable as a number of initiatives were taken by our club. To kick start the year, a **kite-flying festival-cum-social get together** was organised to celebrate the Independence Day of our country on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2012. Subsequently, responding to the grave problem of declining health status in rural and underdeveloped parts of our cities, a one day **health check-up and awareness camp** was conducted in Zamrudpur slums on 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2012 during which Rotaractors performed a street play to make the viewers aware about tuberculosis and tobacco related health hazards. The major achievement of the camp was **Baby Suman who was found having cleft** in her upper lip. She **was operated free of cost** by Dr. T.N. Sabharwal Centre for Cleft and Cranio-facial surgey which changed her life completely.

In the month of October, the club organised a mega event- **“Ek Shaam Buzargon Ke Naam”** in collaboration with South East District of Delhi police, which coincided with the World Senior Citizens Day (1<sup>st</sup> October, 2012). The evening had youth giving various cultural performances for the senior citizens. **Mr. P. Kamraj, Joint Commissioner of Police, Delhi** was the **Chief Guest** for the evening. Words of appreciation flowed in from all the people who came to be a part of the cultural extravaganza.

For professional and leadership development of the youth, the club organised an **Entrepreneurship Summit** that had various experts addressing the audience. The event was graced by **Shahnaz Husain** as the **chief guest**.



**Mr. Rajnish Goenka, Chairman, Tobu Cycles Group** was the **Guest of Honour** and **Rtn. Sanjay Khanna, District Governor Elect 2013-14** was the **Chairperson**. I would like to mention here with immense pride that the summit proved to be a high point for the club as **over 270 delegates** came to participate in it.


