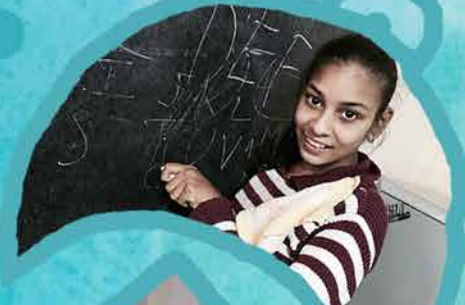
MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

Vision Institute of Advanced Studies has been established under the aegis of New Global Vision Society. The society is registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860 with the Government of N.C.T. of Delhi since the year 1999. Society is also registered under the National Trust Act, Persons With Disability Act and Income Tax Act. All donations made to the society are exempt from Income Tax under section 80G of IT-Act.

The Institute has developed over the years into a specialized Teacher training Institute offering courses in the field of Special Education & Rehabilitation Studies. The Institute is offering programmes approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India with NOC from the Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

The Institute is also offering BA & MA (Psychology) programmes as Special Study Center of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU). One of the other leading programmes is Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance & Counselling (PGDGC) being offered under the Center for Distance & Open Learning (COOL) of Jamia Millia Islamia - a central University.

Vision Special School has been established under the New Global Vision Society for providing services to the Children with Special Needs (CWSN) covering the areas of Mental Retardation, Hearing impairment, Autism Spectrum Disorder & Cerebral Palsy among others. The School is offering a range of services for Early identification and intervention apart from Guidance & Counseling, Psychological Assessment, EP, Therapeutics such as Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Audiology lab and allied services. Special Educators are employed for taking care of the Special Children having valid CRR number 1 registration with the Rehabilitation Council of India.

FACILITIES

- **Class rooms**

Spacious Class rooms equipped with White marker boards, adequate ventilation, and student writing chairs of uniform make cater to the classroom needs.

- **Library**

Library having more rich titles and copies including journals subscribed/ downloaded from the Internet are available. Library facility can be availed by depositing the Library security for its subscription.

- **Computer lab**

A computer center is available to provide support for diverse learning computing requirements. Internet connectivity and LAN facility is available for better facilitation.

- **Faculty**

The Institutes has well qualified and experienced faculty members with a passion to teach and groom the candidates approaching the Institutes. Apart from regular faculty, the Institute subscribes to visiting and guest faculty apart from professionals from time to time.

- **Continuous Rehabilitation Education (CRE)**

The Institute yearly organizes CRE approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) on various topics for the benefit of not only the permanent learners associated with the Institute but also the special educators in the region. Participation certificate are provided by the Institute which facilitates the learners to earn points to renew their CRR number with RCI.



- **Community Based Rehabilitation**

The Institute engages in CBR from time to time. It is a compulsory activity for the regular trainees in the nearby rural and semi-urban areas. Local contacts are developed in the community to not only help in reaching out better in the society but also for providing continued services in the vicinity under the umbrella activity of the Institute.

- **Observation of Important Days**

The Institute observes important international days like World Disability Day, Autism Day, World Mental Health Day apart from local festivals and national days. This is done to create awareness and also initiate a dialogue on the current status and the planning of the way forward.

- **Rotaract Club**

Rotary Club of Delhi Maurya (Member- Rotary International) has established the Rotaract Club of Vision Institute. Candidates are engaged and trained for service projects like Tree Plantation, Blood Donation, Service to the Needy apart from Guest Speakers on Value Education, Motivation, Work Education among others.

- **Educational Trips**

The Institute regularly organizes cultural and educational trips to places of Interest and educationally relevant. This includes visit to NGOs, Special Schools, Bal Bhawan, etc. Also participation of the candidates is promoted in seminars, talks, workshops, debates at other institutes / special venues.

- **Holding of Camps**

Regular camps are organized both inside and outside the campus for serving the target audience with various services such as Early Identification & Intervention Camps, Counseling of Parents, Free Medical Checkup camps, Exhibitions, Community camps for Door-to Door resource mobilization etc.



- **Special Olympic Bharat**

Students of the Institute are trained and motivated to contribute towards the development & growth of Special Olympic Bharat. The trainees are expected to train minimum one trainee in any one of the sport activity so that the beneficiary may accomplish some achievement.

- **Vocational Training**

Candidates are motivated to practice and improve their skills in their areas of interest and skills; so that may as well gradually understand the relevance and importance of Vocational training and empowerment of the Special Children for the same.

- **Vision Special School**

The backbone of the organization is the Vision Special School - Centre for Children with Special Needs. This School offers training and development of these children who are mainly from the economically weaker section of the society. The Centre functions like a regular school and provides services such as School Transport, Individual Education Programme, Psychological Assessment & Intervention, Therapeutics such as Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech therapy, Audiology, Psychological Counseling among other Vocational & Sports training activities.

This Centre is very popular in the region and is providing services to the special children on a very personal and humble basis. Children find this school as their second home and cherish this special relationship & empathetic behavior of the team very motivating & empowering.
